In a ghost-written book called *The Long Walk*, he claimed that in 1941 he and six others had escaped from a Siberian Gulag camp and begun a long journey south on foot (about 6,500 km or 4,000 mi).

He was sentenced to 25 years of hard labour in a Siberian prison camp, ostensibly for espionage as were thousands of his countrymen. In the book, Rawicz claims to have been transported, alongside thousands of others, to Irkutsk and made to walk to the Gulag Camp 303, 650 km south of the Arctic Circle.
